Participating with your computer, tablet or smart phone:

Things to plan ahead of time:

- Download the Zoom app. You will be given the chance to do this automatically when you click a link for any Zoom meeting.
- Have a working camera. Most laptop computers have one above the screen.
 Separate webcams that plug into your desktop computer in a USB port are cheap and widely available.
- Have a working microphone. Again, this is built into most laptops and webcams, and also into many headsets/headphones.

Participating by phone:

Phone callers can hear everything in the service.

Tips for Participating in a Zoom gathering

The following apply primarily to PC/Mac users, but the same features are generally available in the tablet and smartphone apps – they may just be in different places.

YOUR VIEW

- o "Speaker View" will highlight the person currently speaking
- o "Gallery View" which will show you all the people in the Zoom meeting.

 The button to toggle between these is in the upper right.

MUTE

During the service, you will be placed on mute to minimize background noise

VIDFO

You may stop/start your own camera with the button with a little camera on it. If you are experiencing low bandwidth, you can turn off your video.

PARTICIPANT LIST

This list appears at the right of your window. If you are in "full screen" mode, it appears in its own separate window

CHAT

This allows you to send and read messages to everyone or to one other person in the meeting. You can send messages of love and comfort to the family and greet the others attending the meeting. Chat is a function at the bottom on your screen. When you click on it, you will see a chat box on the right. You can type messages and then hit enter on the keyboard. If there is a number displayed in the chat box, it means there is a message there to read.
